TEAMWORK - RESPECT - ENJOYMENT - DISCIPLINE - SPORTSMANSHIP

Rugby is a team game - do your best for your teammates and don't try to grab all the glory for yourself.

Understand the value of loyalty to your team and clubmates as you can't play rugby on your own.

Work equally hard for yourself and your team as this will benefit you both. Be attentive during all coaching and training sessions.

Recognize and appreciate the efforts made by coaches, match officials, and administrators in providing Players with the opportunity to play and enjoy the game of Rugby Union in a safe and fun filled environment. Please inform your Team Coach or Manager if you are treated in an unacceptable manner. Play because you want to, not to please others. Applaud the opposing team and match officials after the match and join them for fun and fellowship after the match because without them we have no game.

Remember that skill development, fitness and enjoyment are important to the game.

Control your emotions. Verbal or physical abuse of teammates, opponents, coaches, officials, or spectators are not acceptable.

Don't show off, lose your cool, pick on other players or generally misbehave – it's not part of rugby. Recognize good play by your teammates and opponents. Play to the Laws of the Game and accept, without question, all the referees' decisions even if they appear to make a mistake. If you lose, accept it with good grace and try harder next time.

Win with dignity and lose with grace. Recognize that everyone has the right to expect their involvement in Rugby Union to be safe and free from all forms of abuse.
